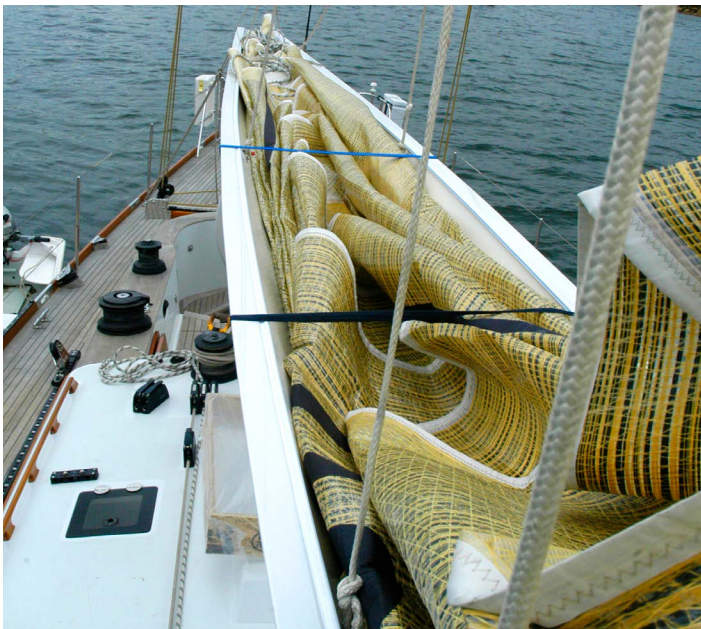




Windwalker - Ted Hood 60'

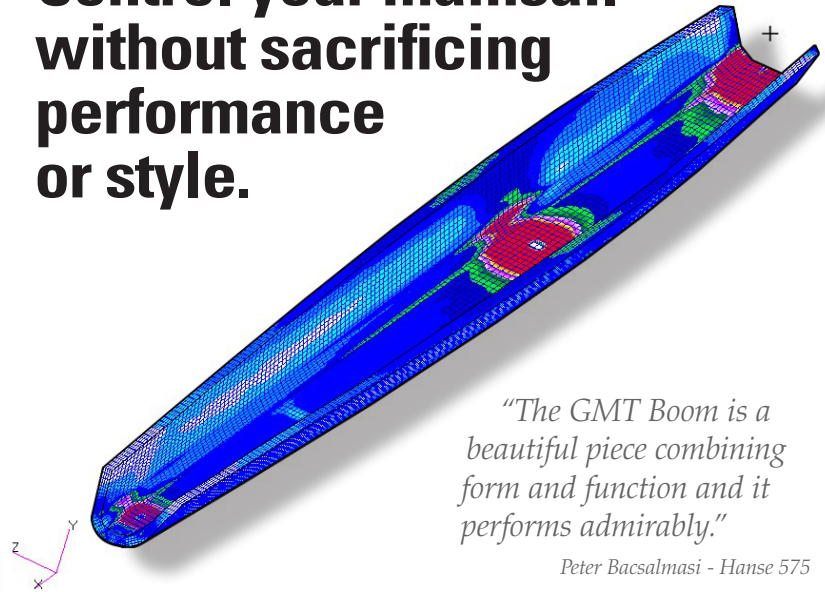


Goshawk - 76' Brooklin BoatYard Sloop

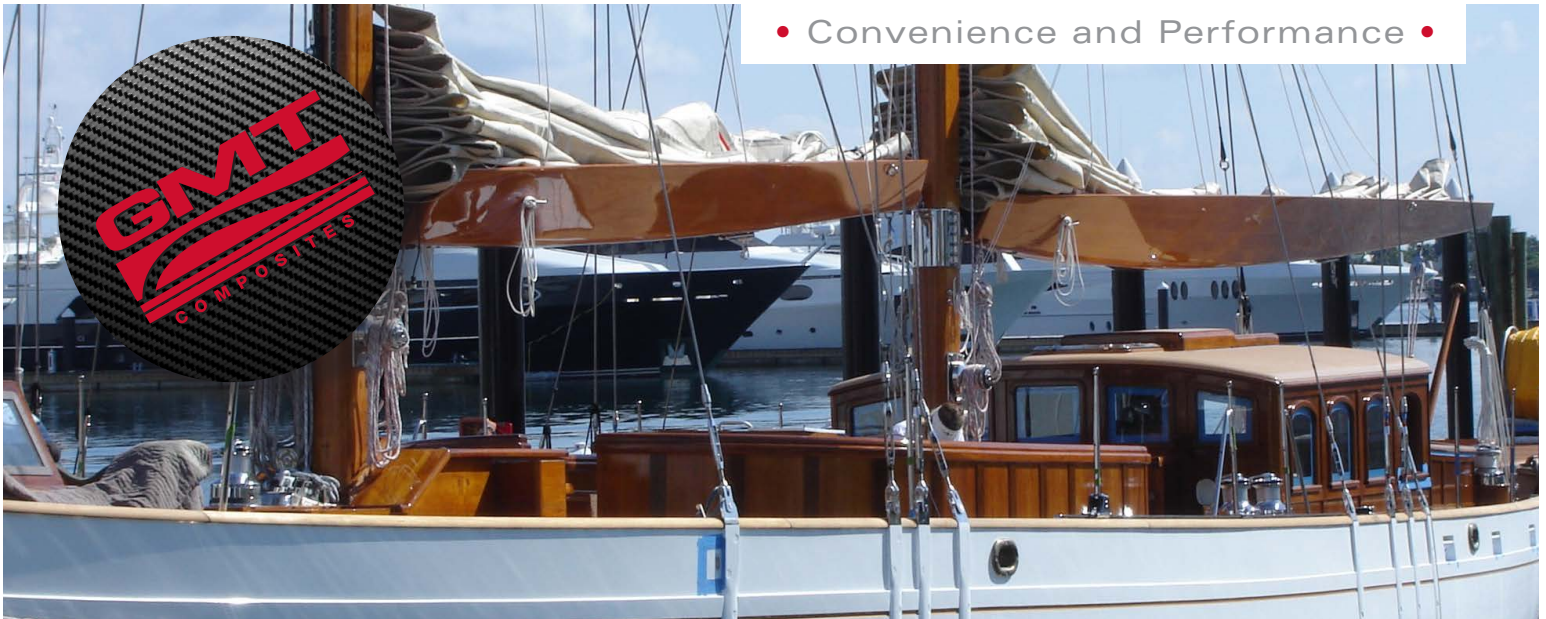
